This Zoom-based stroke rehab theory day is designed for therapists and professional Instructors who are completing the ARNI Institute Functional Rehabilitation & Exercise Training after Stroke Qualification. You have an interest in gaining knowledge, skills and experience concerning rehabilitation from stroke and other brain injuries. You may have provided training for stroke survivors for many years or may not have yet have trained someone coping with physical and psychological limitations resulting from brain injury.
